GENERAL INFORMATION



Information to be supplied for each category

For a company:

- Trade and Industry Register (less than 3 months old)

For new vehicles from Monaco or France

- Bill of sale or purchase invoice
- Certificate of conformity (*Cerfa*)
Or European certificate of conformity

For second-hand vehicles from Monaco

- Bill of sale or purchase invoice
- Registration certificate
- Registration plate(s)
- For private motor vehicles and commercial vehicles with a GVWR of less than 3 T (excluding trailers of - 750 kg of GVWR) of more than 4 years, a technical inspection certificate issued in Monaco. The validity of the certificate is 6 months.

For second-hand vehicles from France

- Bill of sale or purchase invoice
- Receipt statement of purchase
(when purchased from a car retailer)
- “Carte grise” (French certificate of registration) bearing the words “sold on (date of the transaction)” without deletions or alterations. The information must remain legible
- A no-pledge Certificate
(15 days validity period)
- For private motor vehicles and commercial vehicles with a GVWR of less than 3 T (excluding trailers of - 750 kg of GVWR) of more than 4 years, a technical inspection certificate issued in Monaco or France (*). The validity of the certificate is 6 months.

(*) You may be requested to pay for a new technical inspection in Monaco even though you have passed your technical inspection in France, depending on the defaults that had to be corrected, even if in France you had no obligation to do a counter-visit.

Documents to add for taxi or Private hire vehicle:

- Attestation threshold height
- Vehicle specification
- Insurance certificate (form STC080)
